

AusYGN Privacy Policy

AusYGN respects and protects the privacy of our members. This privacy policy tells you how we collect and use information.

The term "personal information" in this privacy policy means any information from which your identity is apparent or can be reasonably ascertained.

Personal information

If you apply for membership we will collect the email address you nominate and any other identifying information you provide, such as a name or phone number. We will also collect information relevant to your membership of AusYGN. Please do not give us other personal or sensitive information.

If you nominate yourself for a role on the committee we will collect your application and make it available to AusYGN members.

We will not share your personal information with other parties unless you authorise us to do so. Access to your personal information is restricted to Committee Members who need it to provide benefits or services to you.

AusYGN is not responsible nor is it liable for; and does not endorse; the privacy practices of web and social media platforms that host AusYGN's social media channels and website or any linked websites.

How we deal with complaints and requests

You may request access to personal information about you that we hold and you may ask us to correct your personal information if you find that it is not accurate, up-to-date or complete. You may also make a complaint about our handling of your personal information.

To protect your privacy and the privacy of others, we will need evidence of your identity before we can grant you access to information about you or change it.

You can contact us by email, or send your request or complaint to the postal address below. We undertake to respond within 30 days. If the request or complaint will take longer to resolve, we will provide you with a date by which we expect to respond.
